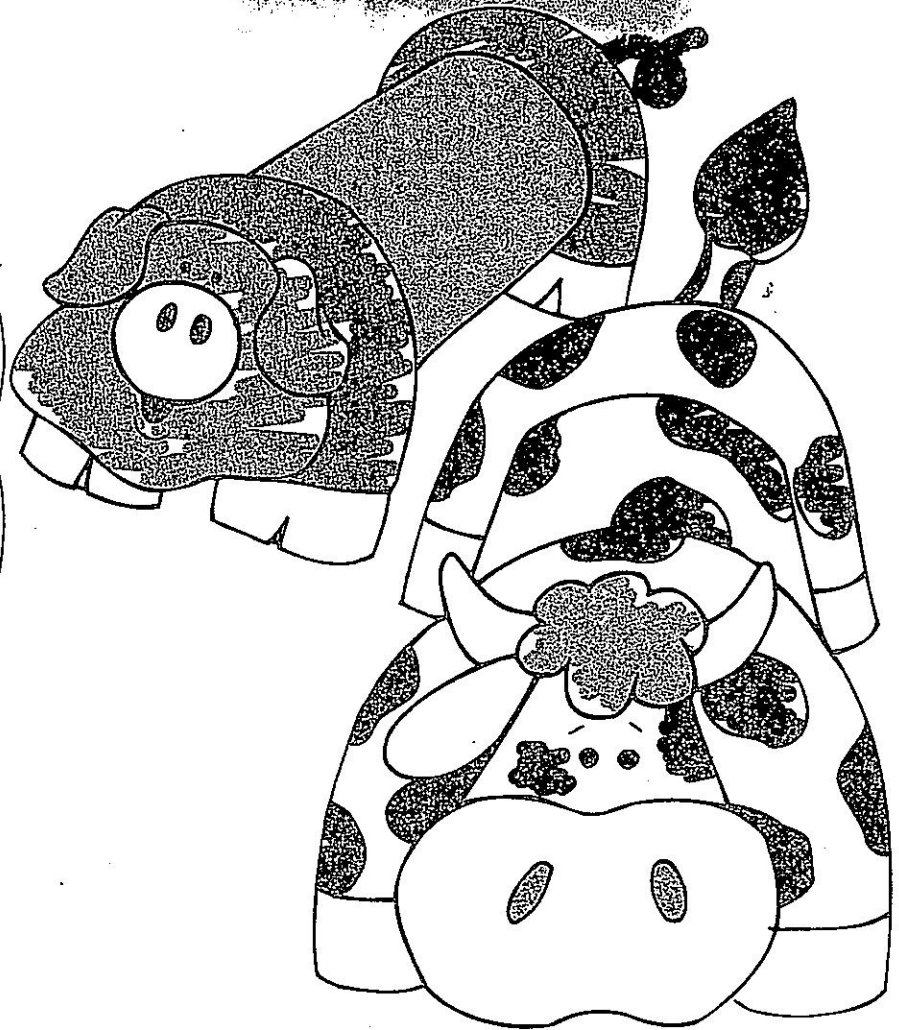
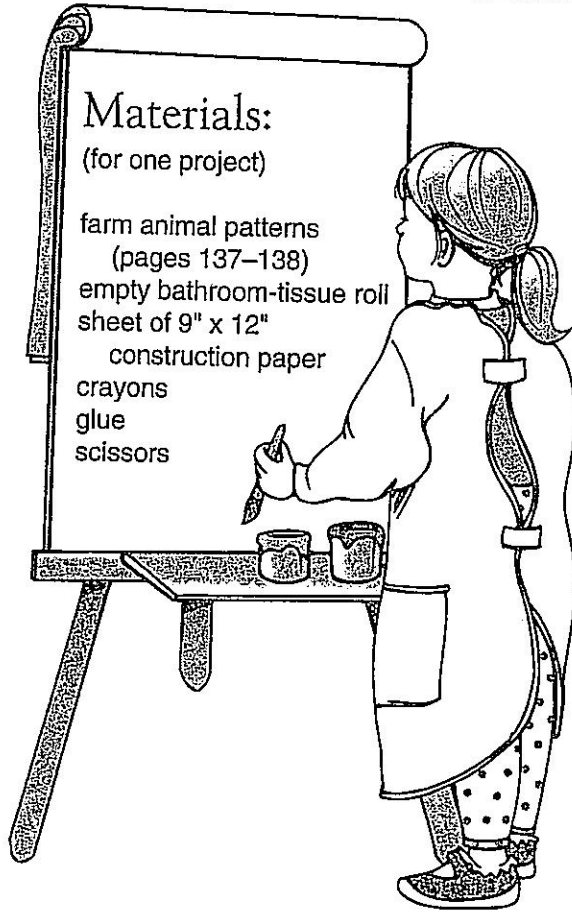


Animal On A Roll

Materials:

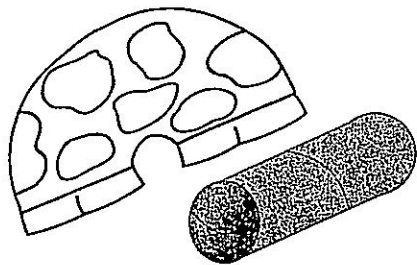
(for one project)

- farm animal patterns (pages 137-138)
- empty bathroom-tissue roll
- sheet of 9" x 12" construction paper
- crayons
- glue
- scissors



Preparation Hints:

1. Collect bathroom-tissue rolls.
2. Duplicate the animal patterns on construction paper.



Student Steps:



1. Choose an animal shape.
2. Color and cut out the necessary patterns.
3. Glue the cover around the tissue roll.
4. Glue on the body parts for your animal. Allow the glue to dry.

Finishing Touches:

1. Create a farm scene with a barn cut from red construction paper, add hay, then display the finished animals.
